Emex Trust is closed and is busy with the sequestration process. SANAS (the verification accreditation body) left Emex with no other option but to stop operations and close down. Our employees only received half of their salaries in December and we are no longer in a position to refund clients.

It is really sad and is a shock to all of us. We all know business have risks and these shocks always come when we least expect them. We thank everybody for the support that we received through this very difficult 8 weeks.

A curator will be appointed by court to handle the sequestration and will be in contact with you shortly to quantify damages you have suffered. The website will be updated to reflect the correct details as it becomes available.

Some verification agencies offered assistance and are willing to give a 30% discount to finish the Emex files of clients that were in process. If you need to access any file, it may only be released with your consent. However we cannot release a file if the certificate has been issued, as it needs to stay as evidence.

We apologize for the inconvenience this has caused.
